PROGRAM OF STUDY

Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Elementary Education (K-6)

A 120-credit B.S. in Elementary Education leads to a generalist license to teach in grades K-6 upon completion of coursework and the appropriate licensure exams. You must select a concentration area in which to focus—English as a New Language or Special Education.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND MILESTONES

TEACHER EDUCATION ADMISSION

- **Admission Deadline:** Apply by **March 7** for fall admission.
- **Courses marked with a "+"** are required for admission to the Teacher Education Program.
- A **minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5** is required for admission, retention, and graduation.

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

- To graduate in **four years**, complete **15 credit hours** of required coursework each semester. (*A part-time program option is available.*)
- A **grade of C or higher** is required in all courses that apply toward the degree.

GRADUATION AND LICENSURE

- Your **chosen concentration** provides the opportunity to pursue an additional teaching license upon successful completion of the required coursework and the appropriate Praxis examination (**5355** or **5362**).
- **Residency Requirement:** Complete at least **30 of your final 60 credit hours** at IUC, including methods coursework and student teaching.
